Chardonnay

Full-bodied and smooth with notes reminiscent of exotic fruits and vanilla spice imparted by the oak.

Dourthe N°1 Blanc, Bordeaux, France 2015 Sauvionon Blanc

Intense and extensive aromatic spectrum. The fresh lemon and grapefruit zest, with delicate notes of passion fruit. Delicious with seafood.

Domaine de la Sensive Grand Reserve, France 2013 Muscadet

Pinot Grigio

Chardonnay

Moscato

Vinho Verde

Light in colour with a slight spritz. On the nose it is fruity, light and lively. On the palate it is light, refreshing and delicious. Bottle 75.

Clos Floridene Graves France 2008

Sauvignon Blanc/Sémillon

Clean and refreshing taste of lemon and oranges. Some creaminess with a smooth finish. Full-bodied, yet balanced and fresh. Bottle 224.

Baron de La Doucette Pouilly-Fume, France 2010

Notes of earthy minerals and lemon give the wine a beautiful structure, balanced by a fruity roundness, with a finish marked by hints of citrus fruits. Bottle 179.

Cloudy Bay New Zealand 2013

Sauvignon Blanc Uplifting aromas of ripe lime and grapefruit, nectarine, papaya and mango. The wine is refined, focused and refreshing. Bottle 186.

Barton & Guestier Beaujolais-Villages, France 2013 Tropical flavours and aromas are matched by some nice strawberry flavours. It has good structure, richness and moderate tannins. There's also some good spice on the lingering finish.

Ropiteau Frerers Burgundy, France 2015 Pinot Noir

Medium ruby with aromas of red fruit and earthy spice. The palate shows cherry flavor with vivid acidity complemented by earth tones and a smooth soft finish.

Baron Patrick de Ladoucette Lex Deux Tour, France 2014 Malbec/Cabernet

A marriage between the delicateness of the Cabernet Franc and the power of the Malbec. With balance and roundness, this expresses all the richness and diversity of these two grape varieties.

Tempranillo

Tempranillo, Mazuelo Blend

Full bodied with good acidity, soft lively tannins and flavours of blackberry and cherry. Well rounded and balanced.

Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon Blend

Intensity resides with bright hues of dark berry fruits that shine as the strong vanilla aroma rises from the glass. Flavours of chocolate and spice are accomplices in a finish that is soft, fruity, and fresh.

Shiraz

Merlot

Hints of plum and brown spice on the nose compliment the boysenberry, blackberry and blueberry finish on the palate. Some herbal notes mid-palate with a long finish

Shiraz

Fruit forward with cherries and blueberries with a light mix of spices and oak. Spicy smell, smooth tannins and a long finish that is slightly sweet and drying.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Deep black-red colour and a rich plumy nose with spicy back notes. The textured flavours are complex with layered fruit and balanced sweetness.

<u>RED WINES BY THE BOTTLE</u>

Marchesi Antinori Badia A Passignano, Italy 2009 Chianti Classico

It is complex on the nose with aromas of red berry fruit, raspberries, blackberries, and ripe cherries in addition to its notes of spice and liquorice on the finish. The flavours are ripe and sweet and are sustained by substantial tannins, round and ample in support of the supple and velvety structure. Bottle 187.

Miguel Torres Priorat Salmos, Spain 2011

Dark in hue and almost opaque, it is fragrant and mineral on the nose while on the palate it is luxurious and oily, but also silky with a long finish. This darkly coloured wine is reminiscent of jam and liquorice, over a smooth spicy and toasted background, which comes from the French oak barrels. Bottle 174.

Luis Felipe Edwards Doña Bernarda, Chile 2011

Deep dark red colour, it shows pleasant aromas and flavours of dried plum, blackberry and violets, followed by chocolate and mocha notes from its aging in oak barrels. A full-bodied wine yet a very soft mouth feel, with a great length. Bottle 178.

Viña Almaviva Chile 2002

A powerhouse, with black currant, coffee, bittersweet cocoa, loam and toast aromas and flavours that run along ripe tannins. Big, lush finish is filled with dark fruit and tar. Bottle 509.

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
